## Medical Spa Injector

Administer Botox and filler injections and perform non-surgical treatments as elective esthetic in accordance with established treatment protocols, scope of practice, organizational policies & procedures, and all other governing standards

#### **Clinical Research Coordinator**

Under general supervision, the Clinical Research Coordinator functions within the full scope of nursing practice, which includes being responsible for the process of patient identification, assessment, planning, implementation, monitoring, evaluation and coordination of care to meet the patient's health care needs in collaboration with health team members to ensure safe, quality care during the patient's entire course of participation in a clinical research trial.

## **Patient Care**

- Assess client at time of consultation and identify health and medical risk factors
- Inject Botox and Fillers in accordance with NYS standards
- Perform non-surgical, elective esthetic procedures in accordance with NYS standards
- Accurately document treatment, follow-up and/or client concerns in chart using approved guidelines/forms for procedure
- Take before and after photos on all clients and download to computer

- Determine the effectiveness of the treatment plan with documentation of client care outcomes
- Reassess and modify the plan as necessary to achieve health and esthetic goals
- Provide accurate, appropriate and immediate responses to all requests by clients, ensuring complete customer satisfaction
- Ensure client has an excellent experience by minimizing pain and ensuring comfort level at all times
- Immediately counsels with Physician for any client concerns or problems
- Have a thorough knowledge and understanding of Medical Spa services and of medical-grade skincare product lines we retail
- Actively build repeat clientele by ensuring on-going high level of customer satisfaction

## **Administrative**

- Oversees data collection, processing, storage, inventory and quality control for clinical research studies
- Assists in budget preparation and negotiation
- May prepare and ensure grant applications, Institutional Review Boards (IRB) and Global Clinical Operations (GCO) documents are submitted in a timely manner
- Coordinates protocols and human subject approvals between various sites
- Assists the Principal Investigator and regulatory staff in the preparation of new protocol submission, protocol amendments and renewals of on-going clinical trials
- Adheres to and supports all Federal regulations

## **Physical Requirements**

- Frequent walking, bending/stooping, reaching and sitting
- Involves occasional lifting/carrying of items weighing up to 30 pounds
- Eye-hand coordination and sufficient manual dexterity are required to operate a keyboard, photocopier/fax machine, telephone and medical equipment
- Frequent grasping, manipulation of equipment and utilization of fine-finger movements
